Schedule: Membership Classifications and Fees for 2008 – 2009

Membership shall be granted to any person who makes application on the proper form, is approved for membership by the GLYC Committee, and pays the prescribed fee. The exceptions are Life and Honorary memberships which are conferred by the Club.

Senior Membership \$230

Provides for a Senior Member who is entitled to all privileges of the Club including the right to sail competitively, store boats, vote, hold office and or nominate officers/members.

Family membership \$300

Provides for two Senior Members, and any number of Junior Members (who form a family unit in the opinion of the Committee), each of whom is entitled to the privileges of individual Senior and Junior members.

Social Membership \$120

Provides for a Social Member who is entitled to all the privileges of the Club, except the right to sail competitively, store boats, vote, hold office and or nominate officers/members

Junior Membership \$40

Provides for a Junior Member (being someone who is older than 4 and is under 18 at the start of the membership year), who is entitled to all privileges of the Club, except the right to vote, hold office, nominate officers/members, or be supplied with liquor on the Club premises.

Student Membership \$40

Provides for a Student Member (being someone who is aged between 18 and 24 at the start of the membership year, and is a full time student in the opinion of the Committee), who is entitled to all the privileges of the Club including the right to sail competitively, store boats, vote, hold office and or nominate officers/members.

Sailability Membership \$40

Provides for a Sailability Member, (being someone recommended by the Sailability Officer) who is entitled to all privileges of the Club for the duration of the Sailability program, except the right to sail competitively, store boats, vote, hold office and or nominate officers/members,.

Training Membership \$40

Provides for a Training Member, (being someone recommended by the Training Officer) who is entitled to all privileges of the Club for the duration of the training program, except the right to store boats, vote, hold office and or nominate officers/members. At the discretion of the Committee, Training Members may also sail in Club races.

Ancillary charges

Wet berth: Deposit: **\$1100** (refunded on termination of allocation)
 Annual fee: **\$450** Application to the Boat Storage Officer

Hard standing: Annual fee: **\$280** Application to the Boat Storage Officer
 Casual Hard standing Negotiation with the Boat Storage Officer

Dinghies under cover: \$75 Annual fee

Member key deposit: \$20 per key Application to the Commodore

Notes:

- 1 The Club has limited hard standing, wet berth and under cover storage. A boat occupying any of these areas but for which the fee has not been paid will be required to be removed by the owner.
2. All trailers to be marked with the boat name and sail number.
3. Members are reminded that parking & speed restrictions apply on Club grounds.
4. Boat storage waiting list - apply to the Boat Storage Officer.
5. Allocations are made by a decision of the GLYC Management Committee.
