## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES.

The Regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and special regulations of Yachting Australia, the rules of the individual classes and by the Sailing Instructions.

For trailables and keelboats the prescriptions and regulations will be Category 6.

Off the beach boats will comply with the safety requirements of Part 2.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all Silver Card members of Eastern Region Clubs or other yacht clubs affiliated with Yachting Australia.

### 3. ENTRY FEES

Seniors - \$10.00 per race  
Juniors - \$ 5.00 per race

### 4. SCHEDULE

Saturday 11 <sup>th</sup> February - Registration	from 1300hrs
Briefing	1300hrs
Invitation Race	1400hrs
Sunday 13 <sup>th</sup> February - Briefing	0900hrs
Heat 1	1000hrs
Heat 2	1400hrs

Presentation - as soon as practical after the last race

Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> February - Provision for re-sail of Heats 1 & 2 if necessary.

### 5. MEASUREMENTS

Measurement is not required but each boat shall submit proof of holding a valid measurement or rating certificate if requested by the Sailing Committee.

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available from 1200hrs on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2011 at the LVYC Clubhouse.

## **7. REGATTA SITE**

Races will be held on the waters of Hazelwood Pondage.

## **8. COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## **9. DIVISIONS**

Division 1. Trailables and Keelboats

Division 2. OTB Monohulls - yardstick 125 and above

Division 3. OTB Monohulls - yardstick 124 and below

Division 4. Multihulls

## **10. HANDICAPS**

Yachting Victoria yardsticks and/or CBH will apply.

## **11. SCORING**

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply. The completion of two heats will constitute a series. Both races will count in calculating a final score

## **12. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones

## **13. PRIZES.**

Prizes will be awarded to the first and second boat in each division. The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the Club having the lowest aggregate score from its two best placed boats in its two best divisions. In the event of a tie, results in other divisions will be taken into account.

The presentation of prizes/trophies will be made at the LVYC Clubhouse as soon as possible after the conclusion of the last race.

## **14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. Attention is drawn to Rule 4. Decision to Race, The Latrobe Valley Yacht Club Inc., its officers, members and volunteers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

## **15. INSURANCE.**

**Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000.**
